We work all four days and man all of SRF's stages, gates, press, signing, backstage and some of us will go to the entrance on Wednesday. Our primary need right now is that we need people for pit/ditch security and the gates in to the stage area. SRF works only with associations and the association receives a grant from the festival which is no more than 1000 SEK per person.

With these money we chose to buy a special festival t-shirt every year. It is after all we who works that are a big part of the Festival and makes it work. It's only the ones who work all days that will receive four meals a day and apart from the wrist band we have a free camping just close by that only we can use. You will have to arrange for a tent or a caravan yourself.

We as an association chose not to keep the money, but to pay each member that have been working an amount of 750-850 SEK as a thank you for participating.

We are a happy bunch of people that work and have a lot of fun in spite of loads of work. We work whole days with breaks of course. Aim for that some days start as early as 0900 and that some ends around 0300.

We make schedules because only half the force needs to work until the last two shows. The schedules we are trying to make are that you work maximum 2 hours in a row followed by shorter and/or longer breaks. We will try to take into consideration if you want to see a band.

We cannot promise you the entire show, but at least part of it. We try to make our members happy so they can feel they have gotten the most out of the Festival. There are a lot of us that has been working since 2002 and are still here, despite the workload. This year we will aim to be over staffed. We need 160 members to handle the job, but we aim for 180 so the workload isn't too big and you will work directly in front of the stages, which is a plus.

We can promise that you will not regret it. You need a Swedish social security number, if you don't have this, you need to inform us. In cases of a Swedish social security number is missing, you will not be subjected to our accident insurance in case of possible damage (never occurred) you need your own insurance to be insured. If a Swedish social security number is missing, take a copy of your passport and attach it to your contract to prove your identity.

So start to plan your leave/vacation for w.23 already now. We start our work on Tuesday, June 5, 2018 and we want you to be in place at 12:00 on the current day. That day we will build barricades in front of 3 scenes and have some practical review. We will get to know each other and the festival area as well. You will get to know the people you will work with, which scene you will work at and who will be your immediate supervisor.
